

ARTICLE 2. EXPLOSIVES, FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS AND L-P GASES

- 7-201. L-P GASES; REGULATIONS OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE INCORPORATED. The Rules and Regulations Relating to the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Industry of the State of Kansas as promulgated by the State Fire Marshal's Department for the design, construction and installation of containers and equipment for the storage and handling of liquefied petroleum gases, the same being Regulations Numbers 22-8-101:108; 22-8-201:222; 22-8-301:321; 22-8-401:412; 22-8-501:506; 22-8-601:613; 22-8-701:712; 22-8-801:812; 22-8-901:907 of the department as filed with the office of the Revisor of Statutes and effective upon the 1st day of January 1966, and are hereby incorporated by reference as authorized by K.S.A. 1970 Supp. 12-3009, and shall be as much a part hereof as if set out in full. All installations, equipment and conditions of the use, handling and storage of liquefied petroleum gases shall be governed and comply with the requirements and standards set out in the regulations incorporated herein. - 7-202. FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS AT BULK OIL STATIONS AND SERVICE STATIONS; RULES AND REGULATIONS. The storage, handling and use of flammable liquids, and the design, construction and installation of containers and equipment for the storage and handling of flammable liquids, at bulk oil stations and service stations within the city, shall be in compliance with the rules and regulations of the State Fire Marshal's Department, Article 7, as filed with the Revisor of Statutes (effective January 1, 1966), and the rules and regulations are hereby incorporated by reference as provided by law and made a part of this article as if the same had been set out in full herein. - 7-203. CERTAIN VEHICLES; PARKING UPON STREETS, ETC., PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or permit to stand upon any street, alley or public place within the city, either with or without cargo, any vehicle used for the transportation of explosive or flammable liquids, substances or liquefied petroleum gases. - 7-204. PENALTY. Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding \$100, or be imprisoned not to exceed three months, or be both so fined and imprisoned. (Code 1973, 7-204)
