ARTICLE 3. GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 15-301. STREET AND AVENUE DESIGNATION. All streets in the city running in a northerly and southerly direction, with the exception of Wichita Drive, Ulysses Parkway and Maxwell Circle, shall be designated "streets," and all streets running in an easterly and westerly direction shall be designated "avenues." The definition of "avenues" shall include Glenn Court and Grant Court. (R.O. 1960, Sec. 14-301; Code 1988)
- 15-302. STREET NAMES; PREFIXES DESIGNATED. Grant Avenue is hereby designated as a dividing line for all streets running in a northerly and southerly direction and the word "North" shall prefix the names of that portion of such streets lying north of the dividing line, and the word "South" shall prefix the names of that portion of such streets lying south of the dividing line. Main Street is hereby designated as a dividing line for all streets and avenues running in an easterly and westerly direction and the word "East" shall prefix the names of that portion of such streets lying east of the dividing line and the word "West" shall prefix the names of that portion of such streets and avenues lying west of the dividing line. Wichita Drive shall be considered as a continuation of Main Street for the purpose of designating a dividing line. (R.O. 1960, Sec. 14-302)
- 15-303. SIDEWALK OBSTRUCTIONS. No person shall place or cause to be placed in or upon any sidewalk or other public thoroughfare in this city any goods, boxes, signboards, or any obstruction whatsoever, obstructing the area of the sidewalk measured from the backside of the curb to a distance of 10 feet, nor shall any person suspend any sign over or above any sidewalk or public thoroughfare in this city, so that the lowest point of such sign shall be less than 10 feet from the sidewalk or public thoroughfare. Nothing in this article shall prevent any merchant while receiving or shipping goods from occupying one-third of the sidewalk in front of his or her place of business with such goods for a period not to exceed four hours. (Ord. 1041, Sec. 1)
- 15-304. SHADE TREES. All trees hereafter planted on parkways in the city shall be planted in the exact center of the parkway between the outer edge of the sidewalk and the back of the curb. (R.O. 1960, 14-304)
- 15-305. DRIVING OVER SIDEWALKS REGULATED. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or cause to be driven over and across any sidewalk or crosswalk within the city any tractor, engine, threshing machinery or other vehicle or implement unless the owner or operator

thereof shall first plank such sidewalk or crosswalk in such a manner that no damage to the same may result. (R.O. 1960, 14-305)

15-306. CURB AND GUTTER SPECIFICATIONS. All concrete curb and gutter built in the city shall consist of <u>Standard Residential Box Type</u> curb, and a gutter 30 inches wide from back of curb to tip of gutter. Curb shall measure six inches wide at base and four inches wide at crown and shall be six inches high. Gutter shall be six inches thick. All curb and gutter shall be poured monolithically, shall be cut through at six foot intervals and shall contain an expansion fiber joint in every 30 feet of length. It shall lay on a well-compacted earth base and all line and grade shall be set by the city engineer.

Concrete shall conform to standard concrete specifications set forth in section 15-104 of this chapter. (R.O. 1960, 14-306)

- 15-307. ERECTION OF GAS, FUEL PUMPS; OKLAHOMA AVENUE. The erection of gas and fuel dispensing pumps upon the right-of-way of Oklahoma Avenue shall hereafter be prohibited at a distance closer than 12 feet back of the right-of-way line of the avenue. All right-of-way of the avenue shall be used only for public highway purposes, and on sig, posters, billboards, roadside stands or their private installations shall be permitted within the right-of-way limits except as provided by statute. (Ord. 369, Sec. 1)
- 15-308. OKLAHOMA AVENUE; LENGTH, LOCATION OF CURB OPENINGS. The length and location of curb openings for entrances upon the highway shall not exceed 40 feet in length and shall be prohibited throughout the curved potion of the curb at intersection streets. (Ord. 369, Sec. 2)
- 15-309. SIGNS; SIGNALS APPROVED BY HIGHWAY COMMISSION.
 All informational, regulatory and warning signs of traffic signals and of curb and pavement or other markings installed or placed along the street shall first be approved by the Kansas Highway Commission, and shall not be installed prior to such approval. (Ord. 369, Sec. 4)
- 15-310. DUMPING EARTH, REFUSE, ETC., IN OR ALONG STREETS. No person shall throw, deposit, place or leave or cause to be thrown, placed, deposited, or left in or on any street or alley, any earth, dirt, filth, sewage, sweepings, ashes, tin cans, bottles, glass or other substance of any kind. (R.O. 1960, 14-307)
- 15-311. BURNING IN STREETS PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to accumulate or burn any leaves, trash or any other combustibles in or upon any street or public way within the city

which shall have been improved by any concrete or asphalt pavement or other permanent pavement of any kind. (R.O. 1960, 14-308)

15-312. PENALTY. Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding \$100, or be imprisoned not to exceed three months, or be both so fined and imprisoned. (R.O. 1960, 14-309)
