ORDINANCE NO. 1216

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII FIRE PROTECTION, ARTICLE 3, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE #1200, FIREWORKS CODES OF THE CITY OF ULYSSES

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ULYSSES, KANSAS:

Section 1. Amending Chapter VII, Article 3, of the Code of the City of Ulysses as follows:

7-301. SALE OF FIREWORKS. The non-permanent display and sale of fireworks within the city, if permitted, from July 2nd through July 4th of each calendar year.

A. Fireworks may only be sold in the city by retailers possessing a city permit from the City of Ulysses.

To secure a permit the retailer will need to present the following to the Accounts Payable Clerk at Ulysses City Hall:

- a. Name and address of business selling fireworks
- b. A 24 hour contact number for the business owner operator.
- c. Proof of safety inspection by the Grant County Fire Chief or his designee
- d. Proof of the business's state sales tax identification number.
- e. A \$300.00 nonrefundable permit fee.
- f. Proof of liability insurance.

Retailers showing proof of non-profit status and/or organizations associated with U.S.D. 214 or other state accredited learning institutions may be exempted from a permit fee,(subsection e.).

7-302. DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS. The discharge of fireworks is permitted in the city limits on July 2nd and 3rd from 09:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; and on July 4th from 09:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight.

A. Discharging or throwing fireworks from a moving vehicle is prohibited at all times.

7-303. EXEMPTIONS. Permission to discharge fireworks within the city at a specific time, for a specific purpose, by a licensed pyro-technician outside the times

and dates listed in Section 7-302 is permissible only with prior approval by the Ulysses City Council.

Section 2. Repeal. Ordinance #1200 and any other ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective after publication in the Ulysses News.
