Insurance Renewal

City Administrator Olson stated the city has received the Insurance renewal from Grant County Insurance for 2020, and the amount is \$106,324.00. Olson explained that the premium last year was \$95,253.00, and last year we received a rebate for \$15,000.00.

City Administrator Olson stated that the city budgeted \$105,000.00 which is short by \$1,300.00 but will be easy to make up. Olson also stated that the city last year had claims in the amount of \$177,000.00. The majority of the claims were due to water wells being struck by lightning.
